That's why your prescription benefit plan includes the High Deductible Health Plan (HDHP) – Health Savings Account (HSA) Preventive Drug List. It gives you an easy way to save on medications you take every day (such as diabetes, high blood pressure or asthma medication).

How do I save money?

You'll pay your plan's applicable copay* for medications on the Preventive Drug List – even if you haven't met your plan deductible yet.

Is it complicated?


Not at all. The Preventive Drug List is part of your plan. All you need to do is present your CVS Caremark® member ID card at the pharmacy when you fill your prescriptions. Your pharmacy will then automatically charge you your plan's applicable copay or coinsurance when you fill any medication on this list. If a medication you take regularly is not on the list, just ask your doctor if a listed medication might be right for you.

^{*} Copayment, copay means the amount a member is required to pay for a prescription in accordance with a Plan, which may be a deductible, apercentage of the prescription price, a fixed amount or other charge, with the balance, if any, paid by a Plan.



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
